

Cardholder Bag

Use double-sided patterned paper to make this cute bag that holds A-2 size cards

Supplies:

1 sheet of double-sided Designer Series Paper
12" Paper Cutter w/ both cutting and scoring blades
Sticky Strip
Ribbon
Horizontal Slot Punch or Circle Punch

Directions:

1. Cut the Paper into a 7" x 12" piece.
2. Score the 12" length at 4-1/2", 5-3/4", 10-1/4" and 11-1/2" as shown in diagram.
3. Score the 7" length at 1" and 5-3/4".
4. Crease at all score lines. Cut at bold lines as indicated on the diagram.
5. Decide whether you want contrasting side to show along the top of the bag and fold the 1" section down accordingly. Adhere with glue or tape.
6. Place sticky strip along the 1/2" edge on the side and assemble bag along that edge.
7. Fold the bottom flaps up and use sticky strip to finish.
8. Punch holes along top edge and put the ribbon through to make your handles. You can tie a knot in the ribbon or use sticky strip to adhere to the inside of the bag.

Your bag is now complete and ready to fill with cards (or other goodies)

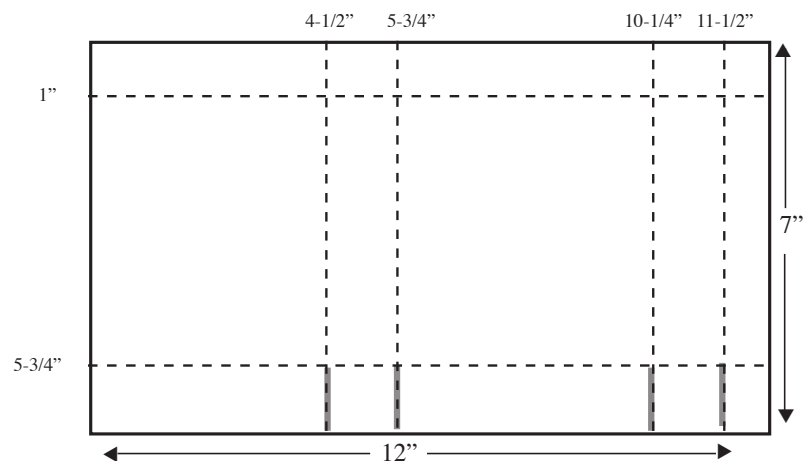
