# 18 Easy Peasy Matchbook Style Treatholders 

Quick and easy treatholder suitable for any holiday.

## Supplies:

1 sheet of 12 " x 12 " Designer Series Paper (DSP) 6 sheets of coordinating cardstock ( $8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ ) Paper Cutter
Simply Scored Scoring Tool Sticky Strip, Snail Adhesive, Dimensionals Oval Accents Bigs Clear Die
Stamps and coordinating color stamp pads Punches as desired
Stapler

## Directions:



Step 1: Cut the DSP into Four 3"x 12 " strips. Cut each strip into fsour 2-3/4" x 3" pieces. You will end up with 16 "squares" and 4 rectangles for a total of 20 pieces (see Diagram A below),
Step 2: Score all six of the 8-1/2" x $11^{\prime \prime}$ cardstock as shown by dotted lines in Diagram B.
Step 3: Cut scored cardstock into three 3" strips as indicated by solid lines in Diagram B. You will have a narrow strip left over from each piece of cardstock. When you're done you'll have eighteeen 3 " x 11 " pieces and four 2 " x 11 pieces. Save the 2 " strips for another project. Fold each piece at the creases.
Step 4: Adhere the DSP onto the 3" x 3-1/2" section. Embellish as desired with Stamps and additional cardsock. Step 5: Place your treat on the cardstock right at the 3/4" score mark. Lift the flap up and staple. Fold over the top flap and you are done!
