

Mini Tote & Cards

Use double-sided patterned paper to make 2 cute totebags that hold 6 matching mini cards!

Supplies:

- 1 sheet of double-sided Designer Series Paper
- 12-3 x 6 pieces of coordinating cardstock
- 12 mini square envelopes
- 12" Paper Cutter w/ both cutting and scoring blades
- Sticky Strip
- Ribbon
- Horizontal Slot Punch or Circle Punch



Directions:

1. Cut the Designer Series Paper as shown in diagram A.
2. Score the two 4-1/2" x 10" pieces as shown in diagram B. (The 10" length at 3-1/2", 4-3/4", 8-1/4" and 9-1/2" and the 4-1/2" length at 3/4" and 3-1/4".)
3. Crease at all score lines. Cut at bold lines as indicated on the diagram.
4. Decide whether you want contrasting side to show along the top of the bag and fold the 3/4" section down accordingly. Adhere with glue or tape.
5. Place sticky strip along the 1/2" edge on the side and assemble bag along that edge.
6. Fold the bottom flaps up and use sticky strip to finish.
7. Punch holes along top edge and put the ribbon through to make your handles. You can tie a knot in the ribbon or use sticky strip to adhere to the inside of the bag. Your bag is now complete and ready to fill with cards (or other goodies).
8. Fold the 12 pieces of 3 x 6 cardstock in half to make your 3" square mini cards. Use the remaining pieces of Designer Series Paper and assorted stamps, ribbons and accessories to embellish the cards as desired.

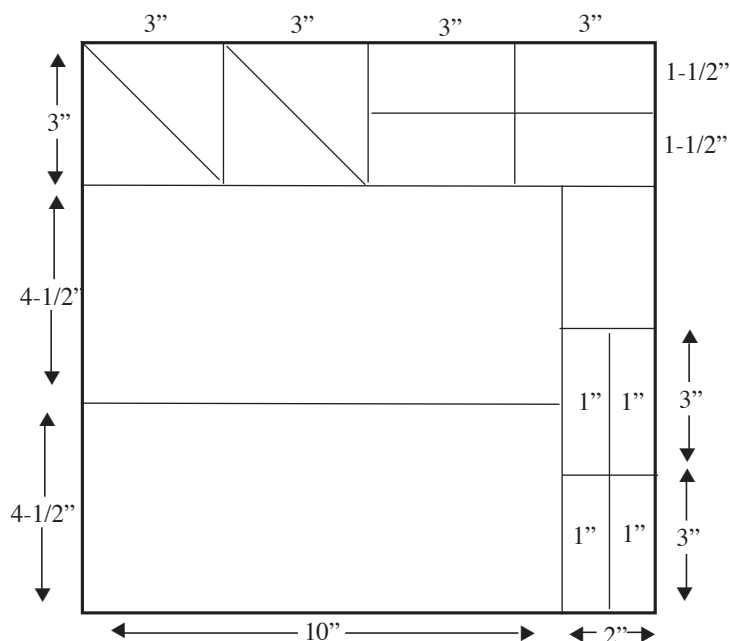

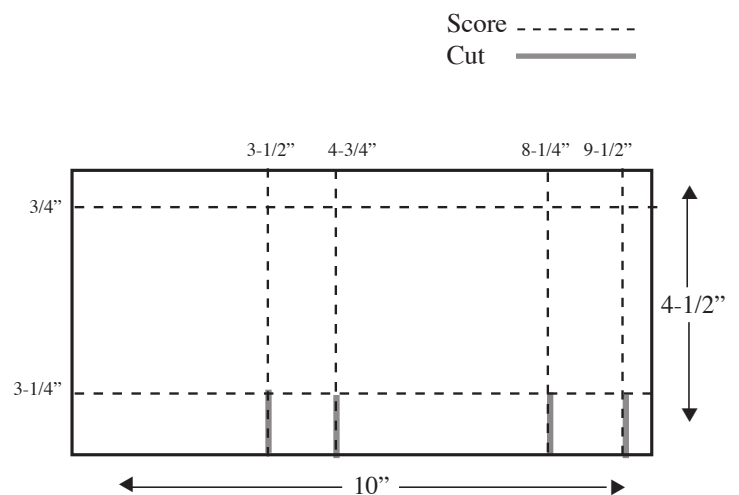
