

# Scalloped Nugget Holder

*Inspired by Nicole Heady, this cute package holds 2 Hershey's nuggets*

## Supplies:

- 1- 2x4 in. sheet of Designer Series Paper (DSP)
- 2- 1x3 in. pieces of DSP
- 1- 2x1<sup>3/8</sup> in. piece of coordinating cardstock
- 1- 1<sup>1/4</sup> x 5<sup>1/2</sup> in. piece of acetate
- 2 eyelets
- SU! Scallop Circle punch, 1/8" holepunch and eyelet setter (or cropodile), glue dot, snail adhesive

## Directions:

- Punch 2 scalloped circles out of 2x4 in. piece of DSP using the SU! punch.
- Fold each scallop circle in 2/3" so there are 6 scallops on one side of the fold, and 8 on the other.
- Punch holes for eyelets on larger "half" of each scalloped circle.
- Attach the smaller "half" of each scalloped circle to the long sides of the 1-3/8 x 2 in. piece of cardstock.
- Score acetate at 1<sup>3/4</sup> in. from each end and crease.
- Adhere middle of acetate to the side where the scallop is attached to the cardstock w/one glue dot.
- Wrap 2 Hershey's nuggets with each of the 1x3 in. pieces of DSP.
- Insert ribbon through eyelet holes.
- Put nuggets in container.
- Wrap with acetate pieces and gently pull the scalloped circles together and tie a knot (I emphasize gently because if you pull too hard the eyelets will be torn out of the paper).

# Scalloped Nugget Holder

## Supplies:

- 1- 2x4 in. sheet of Designer Series Paper (DSP)
- 2- 1x3 in. pieces of DSP
- 1- 2x1<sup>3/8</sup> in. piece of coordinating cardstock
- 1- 1<sup>1/4</sup> x 5<sup>1/2</sup> in. piece of acetate
- 2 eyelets
- SU! Scallop Circle punch, 1/8" holepunch and eyelet setter (or cropodile), glue dot, snail adhesive

## Directions:

- Punch 2 scalloped circles out of 2x4 in. piece of DSP using the SU! punch.
- Fold each scallop circle in 2/3" so there are 6 scallops on one side of the fold, and 8 on the other.
- Punch holes for eyelets on larger "half" of each scalloped circle.
- Attach the smaller "half" of each scalloped circle to the long sides of the 1-3/8 x 2 in. piece of cardstock.
- Score acetate at 1<sup>3/4</sup> in. from each end and crease.
