

# Teabag and Cookie Holder

*Inspired by an original idea from Debi Pippin*

## Supplies:

1 sheet Designer Series Paper (DSP-12"x12")  
4x6 cello bag  
Ribbon  
Crop-a-dile  
12" Paper Cutter  
Simply Scored Scoring Tool  
Teabag, cookie(s) or other treats

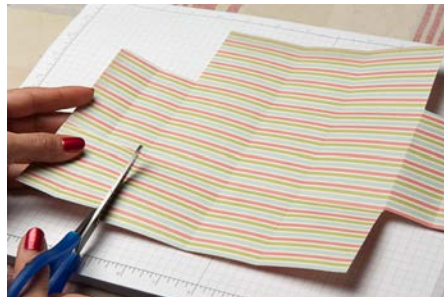
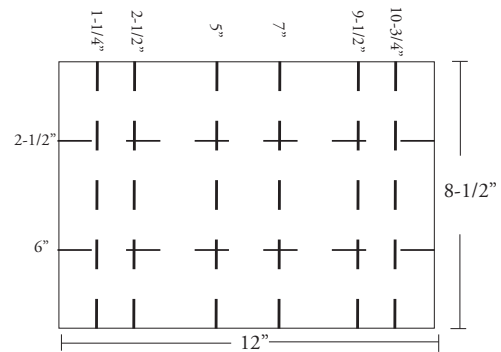


## Directions:

**Step 1:** Cut 3-1/2" off one edge of 12" x 12" DSP. You will now have a piece that is 8-1/2" x 12" to make the holder.

**Step 2:** Score the shorter edge at 2-1/2" and 6" using the simply scored scoring tool (or your 12" paper cutter with the scoring blade).

**Step 3:** Score the longer edge at 1-1/4", 2-1/2", 5", 7", 9-1/2" and 10-3/4" and 6" using the simply scored scoring tool.



**Step 4:** Fold DSP at all the creases and cut off the 2-1/2" squares from each corner and then fold in the four center corners as shown above. Continue folding as shown below.
