## Because I Care Two Sheet Wonder Project

## Make a Gable box and 6 matching cards out of 2 sheets of stamped cardstock and a few extra supplies. An elegant gift for a special friend!

## Supplies:

5 sheets of $8-1 / 2$ " x $11^{\prime \prime}$ Very Vanilla cardstock (or Whisper White) 3 sheets of $8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ Basic Black cardstock (or other color-your choice) 2 sheets of $8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ Baja Breeze cardstock (or other color-your choice) 6 Very Vanilla envelopes (or Whisper White)
Because I Care Level 1 hostess set (or another of your choice)
12 " Paper Cutter with both cutting and scoring blades
Modern Label Extra Large punch
Large Oval and Scallop Oval punches (for sentiment)
Sticky Strip/strong adhesive
Ribbon (approx 2-1/2 yards)
Vintage Wallpaper TI Embossing Folder (or another of your choice)
Basic Black inkpad
Baja Breeze marker, inkpad/refill (or another color of your choice) Blender Pen, Smooch Spritz (if desired)

## Directions:



1. Stamp 2 sheets of Very Vanilla cardstock with desired image(s). Cut one sheet as shown in Diagram A and the other as shown in Diagram B. You will end up with one $4-1 / 4$ " x 5-1/2", two 4 " x 5-1/4", two 3-3/4" x $4-1 / 4$ " and two $3-3 / 4$ " $\times 5$ " pieces. These will be part of your card fronts and the front of the box.
2. Cut 1 sheet of Baja Breeze cardstock as shown in Diagram C and 1 sheet as shown in Diagram D. You will end up with four 4" x $5-1 / 4$ " and three $3-1 / 2 " \times 4-5 / 8 "$ pieces. These pieces are for layering.
3. Cut 1 sheet of Very Vanilla cardstock as shown in Diagram E. You will end up with four 2-3/4" $x$ " and two $4 " \times 5-1 / 4 "$ pieces. The smaller pieces are for the main images and the larger for the card inserts.
4. Run the three $3-1 / 2$ " $\times 4-5 / 8$ " pieces of Baja Breeze cardstock through the Big Shot using the Vintage Wallpaper (or other) Textured Impressions Embossing folder. These pieces are for layering your main Hydrangea images on two cards and the box.
5. Stamp the three 2-3/4" x 4" pieces of Very Vanilla cardstock with the Hydrangea (or other) image. Color as desired. For the one piece that will be put on the Gable Box, color and cut out additional Hydrangea buds and use dimensionals to layer on top. Spray a light coat of Vanilla Shimmer Smooch Spritz over the entire piece and let dry.
6. Cut 2 sheets of Very Vanilla and 2 sheet of Basic Black in half to make 6 card bases ( $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ).
7. Stamp and assemble cards as shown. You will have 2 each of 3 different card designs. Stamp and assemble the images for the outside of the Gable Box. Stamp the envelopes (if desired).
8. For the Gable Box, cut 2 pieces of Basic Black cardstock to $8 " \times 10 "$. Score both pieces as shown in Diagram F. Cut away the four corners of one piece at score lines as shown in photo. Cut on solid lines only for the other piece. Punch handle openings on the $2-1 / 2$ " section of each piece. Place your layered and stamped images on the side that will be the front of the box. Assemble the box using Sticky Strip.
9. Place your cards and envelopes in the box and tie with a bow. Your project is now complete!
