## Christmas Banner

## **Supplies:**

2 pieces of 3-1/2" x 11" cardstock

1 piece of 3-1/2" x 10" cardstock (same color as above pieces)

15 pieces of 1-3/4" x 3-1/4" DSP (can be all the same pattern or assorted)

12" paper cutter w/ scoring blade Sticky Strip

1-1/4" and 1-3/8" square punches (you can also

use the square scallop punch for layering instead of the 1-3/8" square punch)


Alphabet Stamps & Inkpad(s)

Ribbons & other Embellishments as desired



## **Directions:**

- 1. Score the two 3-1/2" x 11" pieces of cardstock as shown in diagram A (2", 4", 6", 8" & 10"). Crease at score lines. Fold Accordian style and cut top two corners evenly to make a tag shape.
- 2. Score the the 3-1/2" x 10" pieces of cardstock as shown in diagram B (2", 4", 6" & 8"). Crease at score lines. Fold Accordian style and cut top two corners evenly to make a tag shape.
- 3. Place sticky strip on the 1" strip of the two longer pieces and adhere to make one long banner strip.
- 4. Cut the top corners of each of the 1-3/4" x 3-1/4" of DSP to make a tag shape. (Note: the best way to make them even is to make a pattern out of heavy cardstock first). Glue DSP pieces to banner as desired.
- 5. Stamp Merry Christmas and punch out letters using 1-1/4" square punch. Punch 15 coordinating pieces of cardstock for layering using a 1-3/8" square punch.
- 6. Place cardstock squares on each banner section, then layer the Merry Christmas letters on top.
- 7. Embellish with Ribbons and other items (such as die cut snowflakes) as desired.
