## DoubleTime Portfolio w/ Cards

## Materials:

 $1-8-1/2 \times 11$  piece of (white) cardstock 3-sheets of coordinating cardstock (cut each in 1/2 to make 6 cards) Additional cardstock for layering 6 envelopes

- 12" Paper Cutter
- 1. Stamp an entire  $8-1/2 \times 11$  piece of (light) cardstock with desired pattern (it's ok if it looks busy-it will look great when cut up!).
- 2. Cut stamped cardstock using template on right as a guide (A-E).
- 3. Cut additional pieces out of coordinating colored cardstock as needed for layering on the actual cards and porfolio.
- 4. Assemble 6 cards and the portfolio by layering the doubletime stamped pieces as desired.

## Portfolio

## Materials:

 $8-1/2 \times 11$  piece of cardstock 12" Paper Cutter with Scoring Blade Bone folder Organdy Ribbon

- 1. Stamp Cardstock as desired.
- 2. Score 11" at 5-1/2" (in other words-fold in half)
- 3. Score 8-1/2" length at 2-1/2".
- 4. Fold cardstock at scored lines using bone folder.
- 5. With the cardstock folded in half, cut a 45 degree angle from the bottom up to the 2-1/2" score line. Open the folder up and fold up the 2-1/2" flaps and close the portfolio.
- 6. Punch 1 hole on each side of closed portfolio at about 3" from the top and 1/2" in from the sides using the 1/4" punch.
- 7. Weave ribbon throught the holes.
- 8. Place matching stamped cards and envelopes in each pocket.
- 9. Close the folder and tie a bow on the side.
