

Envelope Punchboard Multifaceted Box

Project based on a video by Linda Parker (www.papercraftwithcrafty.co.uk)

Supplies:

1 piece Designer Series Paper (6" x 6")
2 piece of coordinating cardstock (6" x 6")
Additional cardstock for embellishing
Ribbon
16 Mini brads
Envelope Punchboard
Paper Cutter with scoring blade
1/4" Hole punch

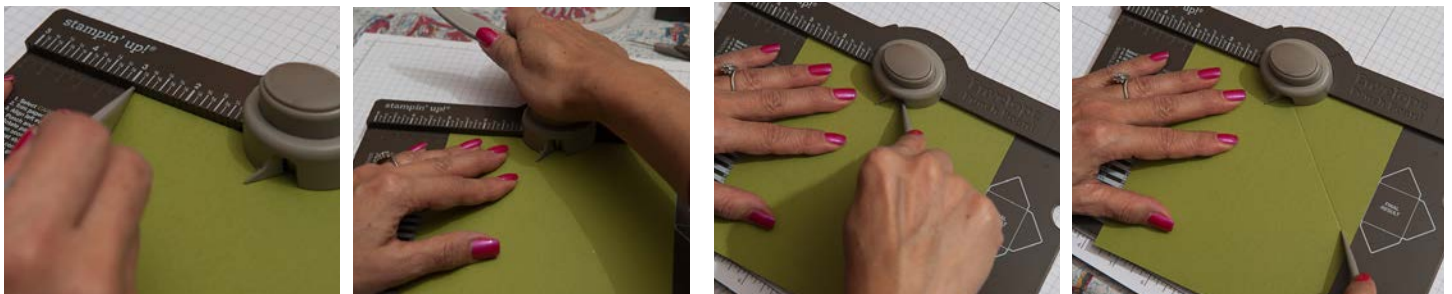

Directions:

Step 1: Place one edge of the 6" x 6" piece of cardstock at the 3" mark on the punchboard. Punch.

Step 2: Starting at the center of the punch opening score along diagonal groove.



Step 3: Repeat on all 4 sides. See below for what it should look like when you're done.

Step 4: Place on paper cutter and score on all 4 sides at 3/8".



Step 5: Repeat steps 1-4 above with the 6" x 6" piece of DSP.

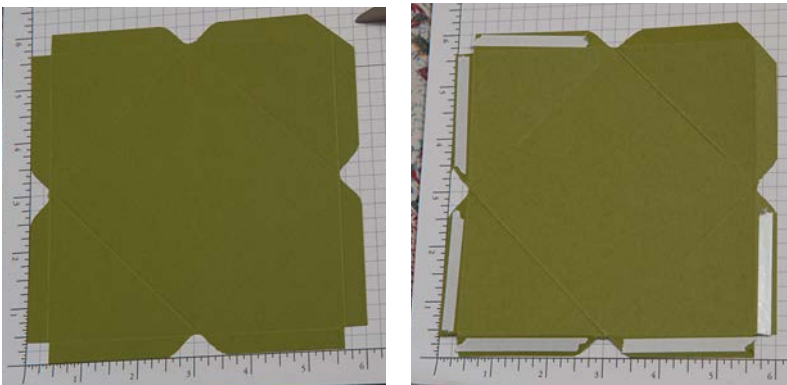
Step 6: Cut off the 3/8" strip along ONE side of the DSP piece using the paper cutter as shown below (alternatively, you can cut off with scissors).



Step 7: Cut off the 3 corners of the cardstock piece and snip one corner as shown in the photo on the left.

Step 8: Place adhesive on the edges as shown (make sure to NOT place on the sections next to the cut off corner).

Step 9: Photo not shown but cut out the 2 corners of the DSP piece as well (no need on edge that is cut off).



The next part is difficult to describe so you may want to view Linda's YouTube video for the facted box. Here is the link you can copy and enter or you can search on the name Linda Parker: https://youtu.be/wD1oLA_aLzU

Step 10: I enlarged this photo so you can see how to align the two pieces to begin putting the two pieces together. You will attach the bottom left piece of the cardstock (note that the angled cut part of it is on the top left) to the top left section of the DSP (note that the cut off edge of the DSP is facing up) at the folded edges.



Step 11: After that first section is put together just continue adhering along the edges.



Step 12: Punch holes at the top and bottom as shown and thread ribbon through holes. Fill with goodies (it fits quite a lot) and tie a bow. Your box is now complete!
