

Mini Purse w/notecards

Use just one sheet of double-sided patterned paper to make this cute purse with 6 matching cards

Supplies:

- 1 sheet Designer Series Paper (12"x12")
- 3 sheets of white cardstock
- 1 sheet of coordinating cardstock
- 6 SU! Mini Envelopes (3-1/8" square)
- Paper Cutter w/ both cutting and scoring blades
- Sticky Strip, Snail Adhesive, Dimensionals
- SU! Border punch or Tasteful Trim Die
- Blossom, Elegant Butterfly and Bitty Butterfly punches
- 1-1/4" Scallop circle and 7/8" Scallop circle punches
- Decorative Label punch
- Textured Impression Embossing Folder (TIEF)
- Velcro coin
- Rhinestone or Pearls basic jewels

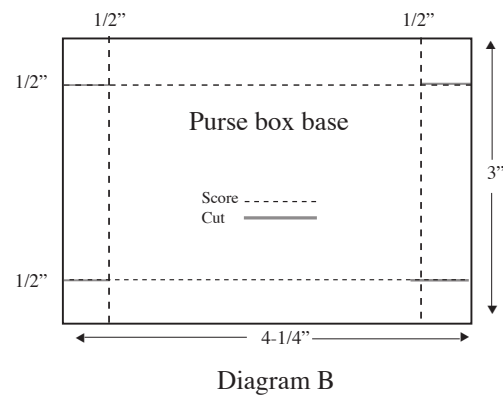
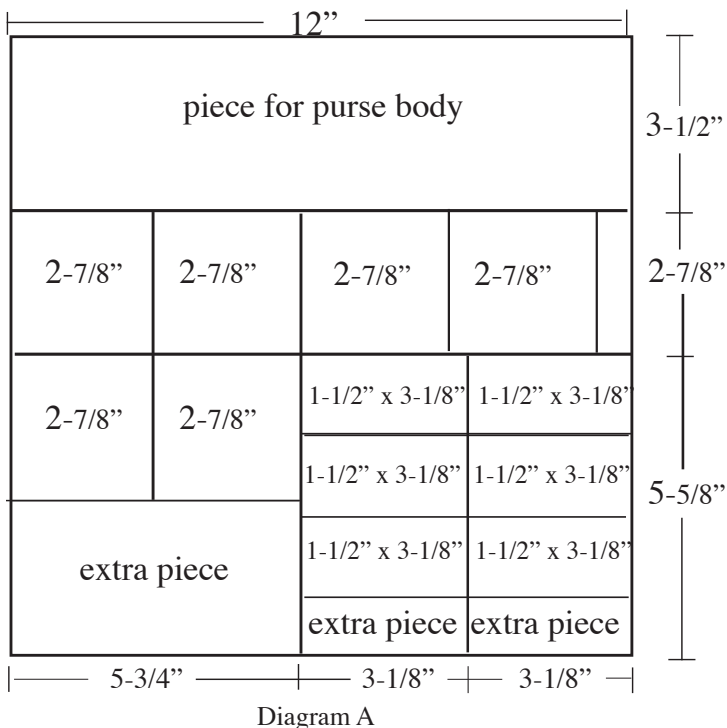


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Directions:

Step 1: Cut the Designer Series Paper as shown in the diagram A below and set the pieces aside.

Step 2: Cut a 3" x 4-1/4" piece of coordinating cardstock and score at 1/2" all the way around as shown in diagram B. Snip in at bold lines and then glue flaps to form a "box" base.



Step 3: Cut a 1" x 11" piece of coordinating cardstock and trim one side using a border punch or run it through the big shot using the Tasteful Trim die. This piece will be the bottom trim for your purse.

Step 4: Cut a 1" x 8-1/2" piece of coordinating cardstock for your handle.

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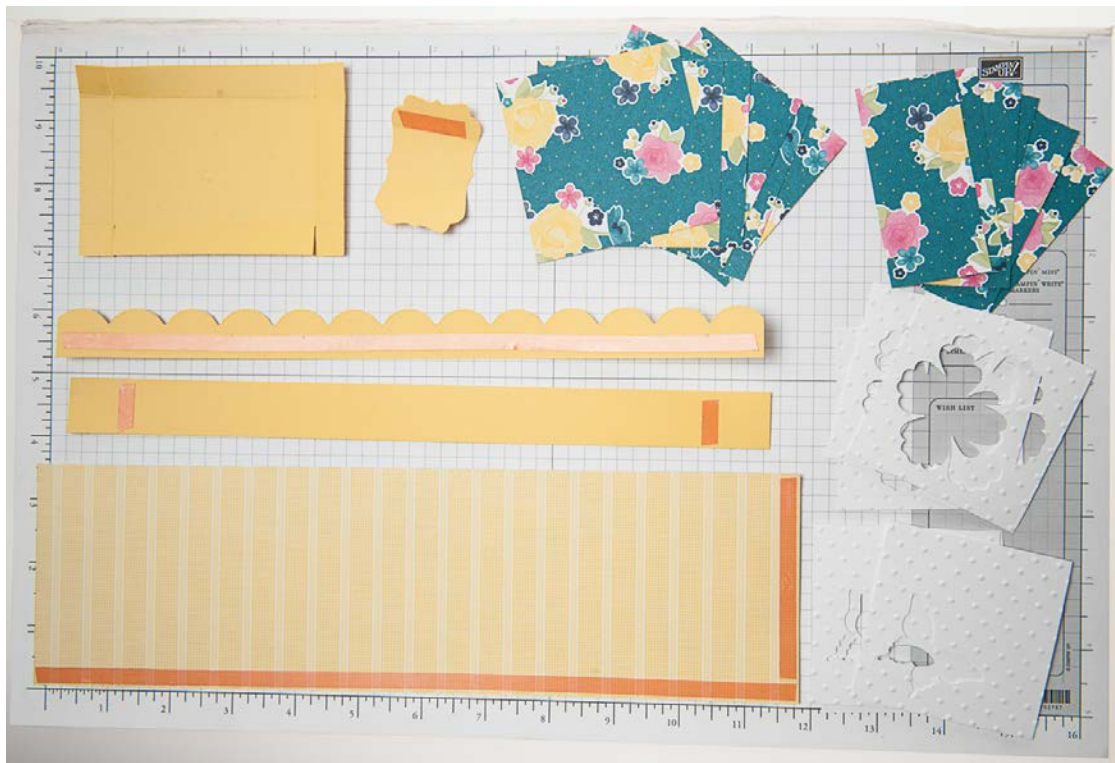
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Step 5: Punch a piece of coordinating cardstock using the Decorative Label punch. Place the middle points at the 1/2" mark to the left of the scoring gutter and score. Move the middle points to the right of the scoring gutter at the 1/4" mark and score again.



Step 6: Cut six pieces of white cardstock into 2-3/4" squares. Use a TIEF to texture these pieces. Use the Blossom punch on 3 of the pieces and the Elegant Butterfly punch on the other 3 pieces as shown in photo below.

Step 7: Adhere Sticky strip to all the pieces as shown below (note that the sticky strip should go on the smaller "flap" of the Decorative label punch piece).



Step 8: Adhere the 3-1/2" x 12" piece of DSP to the "box" base of purse as shown below.

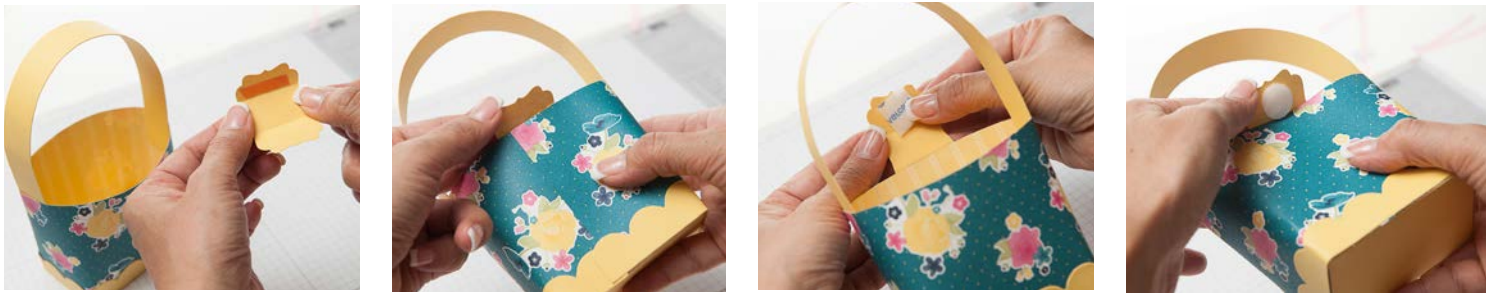


Step 9: Adhere the 1" x 11" piece of punched/trimmed coordinating cardstock to the purse as shown below.

Step 10: Adhere the 1" x 8-1/2" piece of coordinating cardstock "handle" to the purse as shown below.



Step 12: Center and adhere the Decorative Label flap on the back side of the purse. Place a velcro coin on the larger "flap" and adhere to the front of the purse. Embellish the front of the flap as desired.



Step 13: Cut six pieces of white cardstock into 3" x 6" and fold each in half.

Step 14: Layer the 2-7/8" square pieces of DSP onto the cards. Place the punched/texturized white square pieces on top of the DSP using Dimensionals.

Step 5: Punch 3 small butterflies out of the extra piece of DSP and adhere to the Butterfly cards as shown. Embellish with Rhinestones or Pearls as desired.

Step 6: Punch 3 large and 3 small scallop circle out of coordinating cardstock. Snip in at each scallop if desired to make "petals" more prominent. Layer a small scallop onto a larger scallop and embellish with Rhinestone or Pearls as desired and then place the "flowers" onto the middle of the blossom cards.

Step 7: Glue the 1-1/2" x 3-1/8" pieces of DSP onto the flaps of the envelopes. Trim excess if desired.

Step 7: Place the cards and envelopes in the purse and close the "clasp". Your project is now complete and ready for gift giving!



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
